The President, (Mr. Ram Chandra)  
Shri Ram Chandra Mission, Shahjahanpur.

Preamble:

As would be observed from the minutes of the meeting vide appx. 'A', it was decided to organise the above named mission. The association will be headed by the founder Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur after the name of his Guru Samarth Guru Shri Ram Chandra Ji Maharaj of Fatehgarh, U.P., who enlightened the founder with his system of 'Sanaj Marg'. According to the wishes of his Guru, the founder is desirous of imparting his knowledge and acquirements to every individual coming forward to attain it with clear heart and devotion.

1. Name & Foundation:

The mission is founded by Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur and shall be called 'Shri Ram Chandra Mission' after the name of his Guru Samarth Guru Shri Ram Chandra Ji Maharaj of Fatehgarh, U.P., the founder of 'Sanaj Marg' system of attaining spiritual perfection.

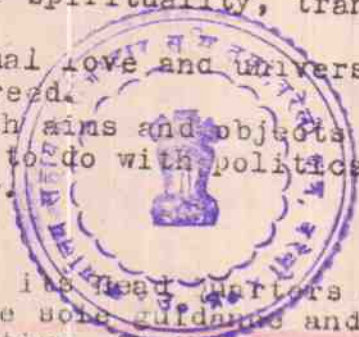
2. Aims and Objects:

The aims and objects of the mission shall be:-

(a) to encourage the down-hearted and promulgate amongst them the easier methods practicable to them, for the attainment of social and moral aims of life, based on the principles of spirituality, translated as 'Sanaj Marg'.

(b) to promote the feelings of mutual love and universal brotherhood, irrespective of caste, colour or creed.

(c) That the mission shall work with aims and objects solely based on spirituality and will have nothing to do with politics or any other activity, subversive of Law & Order.



3. Organisation:

(a) The mission shall have its head quarters at Shahjahanpur.

(b) It shall work under the sole guidance and control of the Founder or his Spiritual Representative, in the direct line of succession; and he shall be the President of the Mission.

(c) The President may at his discretion, establish Branch Societies and Training Centres, affiliated to the Head Quarters of the Mission in all matters of organisation and control, at other places as well, to promote the cause of the mission.

4. Constitution and Working:

(a) The President shall select a Working Committee from amongst the members of the mission to assist him in all matters pertaining to the control and organisation of the mission.

(b) The President shall appoint the following Office-bearers from amongst the members of the Working Committee:-

(I) The Secretary (II) The Joint Secretary (III) The Treasurer and (IV) The Auditor.

(c) Necessary changes in the frame work of the Committee and the duties of the Office-bearers and members may at any time be made by the President, at his own discretion.

(d) A member already entrusted with any office cannot take up the duties of another office, simultaneously, except in most urgent or emergent cases.

(e) i. The President shall preside over the meetings of the Working committee and of the mission.

ii. In case of emergency he may appoint any other member to act for him for the time being but the orders, decisions and actions of such a nominee shall be subject to the final approval of the President.

(f) The President may call a general meeting of the mission at any time and at any place at his own discretion. He may also at his own sweet will, invite the public in general or in particular, in any such meeting.

(g) He shall have a free choice in matters of appointment and removal of members including the Office-bearers. His decision in all matters shall be final; and he shall have the power of veto in all matters of the mission.

(h) He shall nominate among his spiritual successors, any person as his representative, who as such will enjoy all the power and authority vested in the President.

5. Finances:

(a) The finances of the mission shall be under the direct & sole control of the President and no withdrawal shall be made from the funds except with the previous sanction of the President.

(5) The funds shall be divided under two heads:-

- i. the Reserved Fund      ii. the General Fund.

(i) Ten per cent of the income of the mission or as the funds allow, shall go to the Reserved Fund and withdrawal from it shall be made only in the case of grave emergency, by the President.

(ii) Ordinarily expenses of the mission shall be metted out from the General Fund and the withdrawals for the same will be made under the orders of the President.

(d) The funds of the mission in part or in the whole, shall in no case be laid out in any kind of business for material or monetary gains.

6. Membership:

The membership of the mission shall be open to all persons desiring spiritual development, irrespective of caste, colour or creed, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) That he should apply on the prescribed form, duly filled in, through a bonafide member of the mission.

(b) That enrolment as a member shall be subject to the approval of the President.

The membership does not force the person concerned to pay any subscription but it will be open to persons of generous mind and sincere devotion to the cause of the mission, to donate whatever they like or can afford easily, for the maintenance and smooth running of the mission. It will however in no case be obligatory or compulsory for any subscription to be paid to the mission.

7. Duties of the Office-bearers:

(a) President: The duties of the President shall be as mentioned in paras. 3, 4 and 5 supra.

(b) Secretary:

i. He shall keep a record of the proceedings of all the meetings and will be responsible for the proper upkeep of all the ministerial records of the mission.

ii. He shall convene all the meetings in consultation with the President.

iii. He shall adopt adequate and proper means to increase the funds of the mission, in consultation with the President.

iv. He will have a small amount as imprest money, duly sanctioned by the President, at his disposal, to meet petty expenses in anticipation of the sanction of the President. He will be responsible for regularisation of such transactions by having covering sanction of the President and for reimbursing the imprest money.

(c) Joint Secretary:

i. In the absence of the Secretary, he will discharge the duties of the Secretary.

ii. He will be responsible for all the duties in common with the Secretary. He will keep proper record of all the inventory items.

(d) Treasurer:

i. He shall be responsible to keep the funds in safe custody, under the orders of the President.

ii. He shall keep a proper account of all income and expenditures of the mission and make deposits and withdrawals according to the orders of the President.

(e) Auditor:

i. He shall audit the accounts of the mission atleast once in a quarter and submit the audit report to the President for necessary action.

ii. He may also check the accounts at any time, if necessary.

iii. He will also check the funds and the stocks etc., of the mission.

Copy of the minutes of the meeting of the disciples and beneficiaries of Samarth Guru Shri Ram Chandra Ji Maharaj of Fatehgarh, U.P., held at Shahjahanpur on the 10th. June 1945.

The beneficiaries and disciples of Samarth Guru Shri Ram Chandra Ji Maharaj of Fatehgarh, U.P., had gathered at the residence of Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur to pay him homage as the representative of the former, as announced in the 'Bhandara' held on 31st. March 1945 at Fatehgarh.

On the 10th. June 1945, at 8 a.m. a meeting of the above beneficiaries and disciples was convened at Rai Bahadur Buildings, Dewan Jog-raj, Shahjahanpur, the residence of the representative, by Mahatma Madan Mohan Lal ji of Shahjahanpur. The following were present:-

Mr. Madan Mohan Lal of Budaun proposed the name of Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur for the Presidentship of the meeting. The proposal was seconded by B. Ishwar Sahai of Lakhimpur Kheri. It was then put to vote & was passed unanimously. Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji then took the chair.

Mahatma Madan Mohan Lal ji of Shahjahanpur explained to the persons present, the object of convening the meeting, in detail.

The following resolution was then put up and explained in a clear and lucid language by Pt. Rameshwar Prasad Misra:-

Resolution No. 1.

Resolved:

1. That an association, to be named as 'Shri Ram Chandra Mission' may be founded by Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur, after the name of Samarth Guru Shri Ram Chandra Ji of Fatehgarh, U.P., the common metropole of us all, with its Head Quarters at Shahjahanpur for:
  - (a) Encouraging the down-hearted and promulgating amongst them the easier methods practicable to them, to attain social & moral aims of life, based on spirituality, translated as 'Sahaj Marg', the system which has benefited us all, so far.
  - (b) Creating among mankind the feeling of brotherhood and love.
2. That this association will be headed by the founder Mahatma Ram Chandra Ji of Shahjahanpur, who may be called its President.
3. That a committee of at least three members should be deputed to frame out the rules and regulations and constitution for the said association on the following lines:-
  - (a) The organisation shall be entirely in the hands of its President or his spiritual representative whose orders will be obeyed in all sections, branches and training centres.
  - (b) To encourage the public for spiritual attainment, branches & training centres may be established at the option of the President, who will have free choice in all matters of the mission & will enjoy the power of veto.
  - (c) He may select his Working Committee to assist him in matters of organisation & control of the mission & entrust a member with any office or duty, he thinks proper or may make any changes at his own discretion.
  - (d) He may nominate among his successors, any person as his representative, who will then enjoy the same authority as he.
  - (e) The finances of the mission shall be totally under the control of the President. 10% of the funds of the mission or as the funds allow, will go to the Reserved Fund and no withdrawal from it can be made except in cases of emergency.
  - (f) Membership of the mission shall be open to all subject to the approval of the President.

This, although looks to be a sort of dictatorship on the part of the founder (henceforth to be called the President) but has had to be adopted to safeguard the interests of the mission, in case any of its ordinary members or members of the Working Committee try to disrepute either the founder or the mission in any way. The action of the President therefore, will be the guiding principle for all the brethren (the members of the mission), at the centre and other places.

These rules, regulations and constitution, when framed up,

should be put up in the next meeting of the wellwishers of the association, to be held at Shahjahanpur on June 20th. 1945, for approval.

4. That this association may be got registered under the Societies Act XXI of 1860, with the Government of the United Provinces.

B. Harihar Sahai, vakil seconded the resolution and impressed the need for starting the said association in the regular and organised form, as early as possible. M/S. Karna Shanker of Pilibhit and Vishwa Nath Tandon of Hardoi expressed their opinions regarding the formation of the Mission, which were highly appreciated by the persons present.

The resolution was then put to vote and was passed unanimously.

The formation of the Committee to frame up the rules and constitution of the mission as mentioned above, then came up for consideration of the meeting. The following persons were proposed and seconded by persons shown against each, to form the above committee and were elected unanimously:

As agreed to vide Resolution No. 1 in the meeting of the 10th. June 1945 another meeting of the disciples and beneficiaries was held at Rai Bahadur Buildings, Dewan Jograj, Shahjahanpur on the 20th. June 1945 at 6.45 a.m., under the presidentship of Mahatma Ram Chandra ji of Shahjahnpur. The following were present:-

The minutes of the first meeting were read over by the convener Mahatma Madan Mohan Lal ji of Shahjahanpur and were confirmed by the house and signed by the President.

Then the rules and constitution were put up for approval of the house by Mr. Harihar Sahai, vakil of Shahjahanpur. Practically all the points in the rules and constitution were elucidated and explained by him to the persons present.

Lively discussion of the same ensued among the persons present. The active participants in the debate were Mahatma Madan Mohan Lal ji of Shahjahanpur and M/S. Madan Mohan Lal vakil of Budaun, Rameshwar Prasad Misra, Lakshmi Narain Saksena and Ishwar Sahai of Lakhimpur Kheri.

The rules and constitution were then put to vote and after slight amendments were passed unanimously.

The President was then requested by B. Karna Shanker of Pilibhit to select his Working Committee, as provided in the rules. The President after mature thought and judgement, nominated the following to be his Working Committee including Office-bearers:-
